

## FBURA Draft Vision feedback and ideas

- Annual audit as development progresses not to invest in latest fashion rather to include adaptations/projects which are proven “long term stable initiatives” Linux
- Ongoing reuse of free living green open space for example the recent golf driving range and MSAC in Albert Park to the increase of soccer fields (2013) in JL Murphy reserve are indicative of our need for stringent regulation of free living green open space. “Parks and open spaces” that are extensive and expandable (car park to park).
- Underground passenger and freight trains would increase market value by reducing unwanted sound with living green spaces above probably increasing bird and animal sounds (possibly fruit bats and possums!)
- Sandridge Park (p.59) looks like a 'throughfare'. Parks are destinations. Friends of Westgate Park organised a forum 'Biodiversity in the City' 25/9/13 with City of Melbourne planning for a “City in the Forest, not a forest in a city”.
- Melbourne Metropolitan Strategy 1981 heralding dual occupancy that proceeds to reduce backyards/water sensitive urban design/open spaces in 2013. 'Dirt is good'
- Affordable housing (p.23) - For people visiting relatives or friends in hospital. For our increasing prison beds we will need an increase of affordable housing for people who have finished being sentenced.
- Now with two brothels before the projected population increase, global capital cities own street based sex workers who need to be consulted about a tolerance zone in this location.
- Wirraway is an Aboriginal word taken to name a war plane. Wirraway VIC (p.19) and Aboriginal Women's Housing Scheme NSW (p.39)
- Room size is too important to be unspecified – number of rooms in affordable housing provided by agencies, reduced by government intervention to make remaining rooms 'larger'. Support “...all bedrooms required to have external windows.”(p.20 Interim Guidelines)
- Enjoyed a music theatre show(#sorrynotsorry) at Patrick Studios Australia in Plummer Street which is making the area an accessible 'arts and cultural facility'(p.64)
- 5.2 (p.16 Interim Guidelines) Nott Street between Graham and Rouse demonstrates weekly that this is a better design! Along with lane and level with the street car park entrances.
- Walking with a Mother (user) separated from her two year old originally from utopian Melton then seeing her hug the pimp we can think deeply and do. Being in the Capital City Zone accessing world's “best available scientific evidence” ( Royal Australian College of Physicians RACP 2012) practice in Sydney's medically supervised injecting centre (UnitingCare NSW.ACT), FBURA would save lives by establishing a medically supervised injecting centre, KPMG produced a recent review.
- Agree with “Secure key sites early to create new parks and green spaces” (p.46). Re-vegetating with Indigenous flora from Fishermans Bend local nursery skinc and re-establishing wetlands.
